

NOTICE REGARDING REVISIONS TO THE PUBLIC HOUSING "ADMISSIONS AND CONTINUED OCCUPANCY POLICY" (ACOP)

The Housing Authority of the City of Brownsville (HACB) is presently soliciting public comments from the public for the next 45-day period regarding proposed revisions to the HACB's Public Housing "Admissions of Continued Occupancy Policy" (ACOP). The purpose of the revision is to comply with the most current HUD policies and industry guidelines that affect HACB's Public Housing Policies and Procedures.

- The proposed revisions to the Admissions of Continued Occupancy Policy include the following:
 - 1. HOTMA Sections 102 & 104 as per PIH Notice 2024-38

Other minor changes and clarifications will also be included to bring the content current with HUD regulations and guidance.
