

INVITATION TO BID

Sharyland Water Supply Corporation (SWSC) will be accepting sealed bids for the Mile 5 – Conway Rd. to Taylor Infrastructure Relocation project (Bid No. 2024-01-TX05). The project calls for the procurement of materials such as waterline pipe and fittings ranging from 2" to 20" in diameter. Also needed will be approximately 7,000 LF of boring services for multiple road crossings ranging from 2" to 30" in diameter.

**Component 2: Boring Services
(Services Only - Materials Provided by SWSC)**

All interested and qualified bidders are invited to submit their sealed bids to SWSC at 321 S. Shary Blvd., Alton, TX. by **Friday, May 2, 2025, at 3:00 P.M.** Bids will be opened and read aloud at this location and time in the presence of the bidders or their representatives. Presence is not mandatory. Bids received after the deadline will not be accepted.

A Pre-Bid Conference meeting has been scheduled for **Monday, April 28, 2025, at 3:00 P.M.** at SWSC Main Office, 321 S. Shary Blvd., Alton, TX.

Bidders must comply with Section 70901 of P. L. 117-58 of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, 2021 (regarding the Build America, Buy America Act).
