



# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE USE OF TYPE B SALES TAX FUNDS

Notice is hereby given that the Brownsville Community Improvement Corporation (BCIC), pursuant to the Texas Local Government Code Sec. 505.159, will conduct a PUBLIC HEARING to consider the expenditure of Type B sales tax funds during a BCIC Board Meeting on Monday, March 23rd, 2026, at 5:30 P.M. at the eBridge Center for Business and Commercialization located at 1304 E. Adams Street, Brownsville, Cameron County, Texas 78520.

The Public Hearing will be conducted for the following projects, which are to be considered Quality of Life Projects, totaling \$1,024,609.00 for Fiscal Year 2026:

- **Project #26-001 for Duck Head Nature and Research Center with UTRGV Foundation**, not to exceed Three Hundred Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (**\$300,000**) for the development and construction of a trail network, water pier, and multi-use building.
- **Project #26-002 for Strengthening Brownsville's Women's Health Service Infrastructure with Brownsville Community Health Clinic Corporation DBA New Horizon**, not to exceed Two Hundred Seventy Five Thousand Three Hundred Six Dollars and Zero Cents (**\$275,306**) for purchase and installation of a 3D Mammogram unit.
- **Project #26-003 for Garden of Resilience: Healing & Community Reflection Space with Friendship of Women**, not to exceed One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (**\$160,000**) for a traumainformed, nature-based wellness space.
- **Project #26-004 for Innovation and Access for All with Children's Museum of Brownsville**, not to exceed One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (**\$110,000**) for restoring aging primary exhibits to include ADA accessibility.
- **Project #26-005 for Fort Brown Heritage Walk with Texas Southmost College**, not to exceed One Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Three Hundred Three Dollars and Zero Cents (**\$179,303**) for the restoration of the welcome center, wayfinding signage, and the virtual tour.

The BCIC Board of Directors, in its sole discretion, may determine the total amount of funds awarded and any other terms. Projects approved by the BCIC Board of Directors will require additional approval by the Brownsville City Commission. Approved project(s) cannot begin, nor can any expenses be incurred, until the project agreement has been executed.
